MOP Co-Op Literacy Consultant

DESCRIPTION:

Employment as a Literacy Consultant who can work with the local district elementary schools and the MOISD Career and Technical Education Center's faculty to improve and enhance literacy-related instruction.

REQUIREMENTS:

A minimum of a Master's Degree in reading with at least five (5) years of educational experience as a classroom teacher and/or administrator. Experience with reading intervention and/or reading remediation programs and an understanding of secondary ELA curriculum are required.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Organize, plan and conduct professional development sessions, training programs, and conferences for local districts.
- 2. Act as MOISD liaison to the Michigan Department of Education related to English Language Arts for the K-12 level.
- 3. Participate as an active team member in organization projects as assigned.
- 4. Participate in local district needs assessments and planning.
- 5. Plan, use professional judgment and act effectively to carry out the functions of this position within the direction provided by the MOISD mission and goals.
- 6. Assume responsibility to transport self to assigned worksites.
- 7. Maintain regular and predictable attendance.
- 8. Pursuant to "School Safety" legislation (2005 PA 129-131 and 138) enacted into law January 1, 2006, must pass a criminal history background investigation conducted by the Michigan State Police (MSP) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).
- 9. Other duties as assigned by the Director of General Education, Superintendent or designee.
